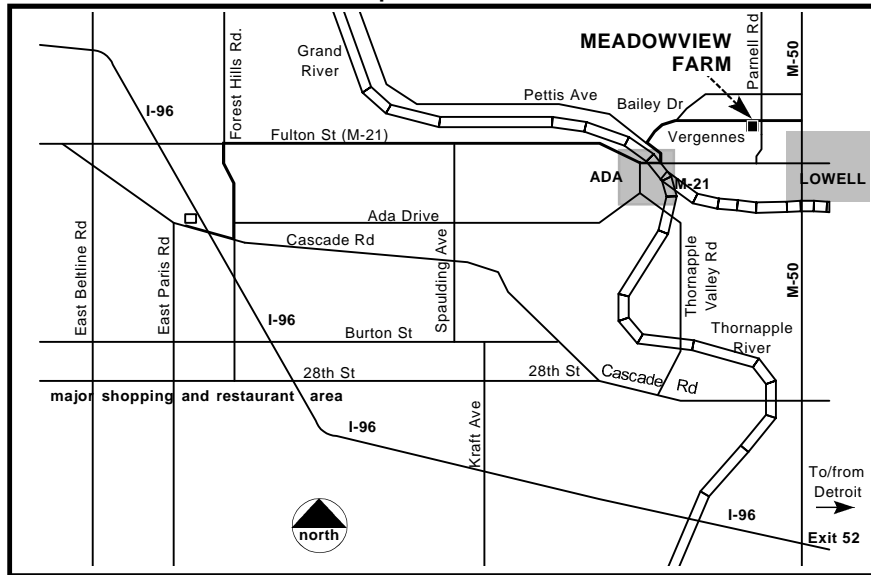

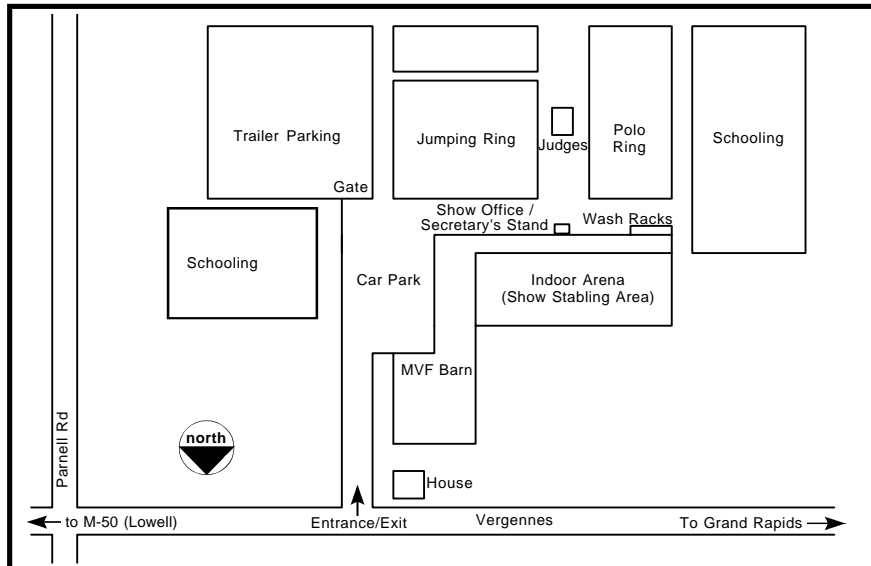

For points to count toward the MHJA Annual Championship, this form and fees must be postmarked or submitted on/before the last day of competition. Recording applications will not be accepted by show secretaries. You must use your recording name/number on MHJA show entry forms in order for points to count toward the division annual championships.

MHJA MEDAL CLASSES / PLEASURE CLASS

MHJA Medal Classes

Eligibility: Open to all current MHJA Junior and Adult members in good standing.

Qualifying Classes: MHJA Medal classes will be offered at each MHJA Local Member, Regular Member, and Pony Show.

Medal Ride-off: A Medal Ride-off will be held for each Medal division at a designated MHJA show at the end of the show season. There will be no qualifying classes held at this show. To qualify for the Final Medal Ride-off, a rider must win: One blue ribbon in a qualifying class (rider then becomes ineligible to compete in the qualifying classes and will receive a medal); Two red ribbons in a qualifying class (rider may continue to compete); Pony riders see Rule XVI, Part II, Sec.5. A rider who wins the Final Medal Ride-off class two times is no longer eligible to compete in that medal, and will be presented with an award at the Annual Awards banquet. Exception: Young Riders Medal and Open Adult Medal. Ribbons won in Medal classes do affect a rider's eligibility in equitation classes. Winning a Limit Medal Ride-off class does not automatically eliminate a rider from the Limit division (unless this is rider's sixth blue ribbon).

Course Requirements: Must be a figure-eight course of not less than six obstacles, which must include one combination and two changes of lead, after the first obstacle. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. Only one rider per horse. To fill a class, four competitors must complete the course.

MHJA Young Riders Medal

Open to Junior riders 14 years and under. Fences not to exceed 2'9" in height. Riders may compete on ponies, but the course will not be adjusted. Tests 1-8, 10. (Rule XII). Sponsored by The Sporthorse Saddlery.

MHJA Limit Junior Medal

Open to all current MHJA Junior members who fulfill the same eligibility requirements as outlined in Rule XI, Part II, Sec. 1.b.1. Riders may cross enter into Open Junior Medal. Fences not to exceed 3' in height. Tests 1-11. (Rule XII). Sponsored by Wyldewood Tack and Trailer.

MHJA Limit Adult Medal

Open to all current MHJA Adult members who fulfill the same eligibility requirements as outlined in Rule XI, Part II, Sec. 2.b.1. Riders may cross enter into Open Adult Medal. Fences not to exceed 2'9" in height. Tests 1-8, 10. (Rule XII). Sponsored by Select Underwriters.

MHJA Open Junior Medal

Open to all current MHJA Junior members. Fences not to exceed 3'3" in height. Tests 1-19. (Rule XIV). Sponsored by Rochester Hills Stable and Tack.

MHJA Open Adult Medal

Open to all current MHJA Adult members. Fences not to exceed 3' in height. Tests 1-19. (Rule XII). Sponsored by Amberway Stable.

MHJA Jr/Adult Mini Medal

Open to all current MHJA Adult members. Fences not to exceed 2' in height, with no oxers.

Pleasure Class

Beach Bareback Pleasure Class: Open to all riders. Hard hats required. Walk-Trot classes will be judged on suitability for a beach pleasure horse or pony. Beach wear (bikinis, etc.) is optional.

MEADOWVIEW FARM SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

ENTRIES: Entries close on Tuesday prior to the show. NO FAX OR PHONE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. All entry forms must be signed by the owner or his/her authorized agent and trainer, and accompanied by a check for all fees. Make Checks payable to Meadowview Farm, Inc. All checks must be signed. All riders must have a signed entry form in the show office before they school in any ring.

Entry Fees are \$18.00 per class. A flat post entry fee of \$20.00 will be charged for those not entered by 6 p.m. Tuesday prior to the show. A processing fee of \$40.00 plus collection fees will be made for all non-negotiable checks. MHJA Horse Show Evaluation Forms are available in the Secretary's Stand (Show Office).

Please include copies of all MHJA membership and nomination cards, or be prepared to fill out an affidavit before receiving show numbers. Entry fees are refundable only when a veterinarian's certificate is presented to the show secretary prior to the class/classes involved. No stall refunds will be given.

STABLING: Stall fees are \$75.00 per stall (Meadowview Farm's special "economic stimulus" rate for this show). Stalls must be paid in full to guarantee the reservation. Stalls will be available Thursday prior to the show after 9:00 AM, and horses arriving before that time will be charged an additional \$10.00 per day. Arrangements for early arrivals must be made in advance with the Stable Manager. Stabling consists of 10' x 10' wooden stalls with doors in the permanent buildings, and portable stabling with stall guards in the indoor ring.

Horses showing from trailers may do so only with permission of Management. NON-SHOWING HORSES stabled on the grounds will be charged an additional \$75.00. Non-showing horses must have a COMPLETED and SIGNED ENTRY BLANK on file in the show office BEFORE SCHOOLING. If you enter a class and scratch you will be considered a non-showing horse, unless you have a veterinarian's certificate from the on-call veterinarian.

SCHOOLING: Schooling will be available during the following times (subject to change). THURS: FRI: 6:00–7:30 a.m., SAT: 6:00–7:30 a.m., SUN: 6:00–7:30 a.m. All courses will be set on a 12' stride measurement. Please Note: No schooling allowed over medal courses.

MEDIC: Will be on duty all show days. Medic fees are \$6.00 per rider for the show.

HEADGEAR: All Riders MUST wear approved headgear (ASTM / SEI certified helmet) with harness secured while mounted on the show grounds. Adults are required to wear hard hats when jumping anywhere on the showgrounds.

NO SMOKING IN THE BARN AND INDOOR AREAS!

CAMPING: Camper fees are \$75.00 per weekend, with any additional nights \$10.00. Space is extremely limited and you must reserve a space in advance, by telephone.

DOGS: NO DOGS ALLOWED! Visiting dogs are a disturbance to our exhibitors, so please leave your dogs at home or kennel them nearby. See page 3 for a list of nearby kennels.

PONY MEASUREMENT: There is a \$10 measurement fee for ALL ponies. No one is exempt from this measurement fee. The measurement fee and the measurement form are to be mailed to the MHJA Office where a measurement card will be issued and mailed to the owner. A scheduled measure time will be posted.

GENERAL NOTES: An order of go will be posted and followed in all Medal and Jumper classes. Prior to your other over fences classes, please post your number with the starter at the in-gate. This will help riders and trainers in their warm up, promote prompt entry into the ring, and will help expedite the show.

In some cases the area of the Courtesy Circle may be restricted by a mandatory line. This will be indicated on the course diagram and physically in the ring.

If entries warrant, the class schedule and arenas may be altered to accommodate a one judge show.

MHJA 2011 PONY CLASS SPECIFICATIONS (continued)

Children's Pony Equitation: Open to Junior riders mounted on ponies. Riders may not have won three blue ribbons over fences in equitation classes at MHJA Pony or Regular Member shows. Ribbons won in Short Stirrup or Novice Pony equitation divisions do not affect a rider's eligibility for this division. In addition, riders may not have won 15 points in recognized equitation classes at MHSA or AHSA shows. No in-and-out. No tests.

Children's Small/Medium Pony Equitation — Fences 2'. Children's Large Pony Equitation — Fences 2' 6".

Novice Pony Equitation: Open to Junior riders who have not won three blue ribbons in Equitation classes at MHJA Pony shows or Regular Member shows. Ribbons won in the Short Stirrup division do not affect a rider's eligibility for this division. In addition, riders may not have won 15 points in recognized equitation classes at MHSA or AHSA shows. No in-and-out. No tests.

Novice Small/Medium Pony Equitation — Fences 2'. Novice Large Pony Equitation — Fences 2'.

Pony Equitation 12 Years and Under: Open to Junior riders 12 years and under, mounted on ponies. Fences: Large ponies 2' 9", Medium ponies 2' 3", Small ponies 2'. Tests: #1 – 9 over fences; #1 – 5, 8 & 9 on the flat classes.

Pony Equitation 13 – 17 Years: Open to Junior riders 13 – 17 years of age. Fences: Large ponies 2' 9", Medium ponies 2' 3", Small ponies 2'. Tests: #1 – 9 over fences; #1 – 5, 8 & 9 on the flat classes.

MHJA Pony MEDAL: Open to Junior riders who are current members of MHJA. Tests 19 (Rule XIV). Fences: Large 2' 9", Medium 2' 3", Small 2'.

Pony Mini MEDAL: Open to Junior riders mounted on ponies. Riders may not have won 3 blue ribbons over fences in Equitation classes at MHJA Pony or Regular Member shows. It is not open to juniors who have ridden in the Small/Medium/Large Pony Hunter divisions, the Pony Equitation 11 and Under division, or the Pony Medal. In addition, riders may not cross enter into any of those divisions. Ribbons won in the Short Stirrup or Novice Pony Equitation divisions do not affect a rider's eligibility for this class. Riders may not have won 15 points in recognized Equitation classes at USEF shows. Winning 15 USEF points will make a rider immediately ineligible for this class. Riders can't "point out" with MHJA points during the show season. Fences: 2' for all ponies. Course to be set on a 12' stride. No "In-and-Outs" or Oxers. Tests: #1 – 6. Judges are encouraged to test the top 4 riders. Pony Mini Medal classes may not be combined with Pony Medal classes.

Pony Warm Up: Open to all ponies ridden by Juniors. Fences: Large 2' 9", Medium 2' 3", Small 2'. Children's Pony Warm Up — fences: Large — 2' 6", Small/Medium — 2' Novice/ Short Stirrup — fences 2'

MHJA 2011 PONY CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

Pony Hunter: Open to ponies of any age ridden by a Junior. No pony may be entered in a pony class unless they possess a current measurement card.

SMALL PONY — not to exceed 12.2 hands. No rider over 12 years of age may compete on a Small Pony. Fences 2'.

MEDIUM PONY — not to exceed 13.2 hands. No rider over 14 years of age may compete on a Medium Pony. Fences 2' 3".

LARGE PONY — not to exceed 14.2 hands. Fences 2' 9".

Children's Pony Hunter: Open to Junior riders who have not have not won three blue ribbons over fences in hunter classes at MHJA Pony or Regular Member Shows. In addition, riders may not have won 15 points in recognized hunter classes at MHSA or AHSA Shows. Ribbons won in Short Stirrup or Novice Pony Hunter divisions do not affect a rider's eligibility for this division. No in-and-out.

Children's Small/Medium Hunter — Fences 2'.

Children's Large Pony Hunter — Fences 2' 6".

Novice Pony Hunter: Open to Junior riders who have not shown in any open hunter or equitation divisions at MHJA, MHSA or AHSA Pony or Regular Member shows. Open divisions include: MHJA Pony and AHSA Medals, Small, Medium & Large Pony Hunters, Pony Equitation 12 & Under and 13 thru 17, MHJA Open Junior Medal and AHSA Medals. Riders having won in the Novice Pony Hunter division do not lose their Children's Pony Hunter status. No in-and-out. Fences 2'.

Short Stirrup Pony Hunter: Open to Junior riders 11 years of age and under. These riders may not have won 9 blue ribbons over fences in a recognized equitation class at MHJA, MHSA, or AHSA Shows, prior to October 1st of the preceding year. Riders do retain their Short Stirrup status for the entire show year. Riders may not have shown in any open hunter or equitation division (see Novice Hunter). Riders having won in the Short Stirrup division do not lose their Maiden or Novice status. Short Stirrup riders may not ride in Children's Pony Hunter or Equitation divisions.

Short Stirrup Small/Medium and Large Pony Hunter — Fences 18" for Small/Medium, 2' for Large.

Short Stirrup Pony Equitation: Open to Junior riders 11 years of age and under. These riders may not have won 3 blue ribbons over fences in a recognized equitation class at MHJA, MHSA, or AHSA Shows, prior to October 1st of the preceding year. Riders do retain their Short Stirrup status for the entire show year. Riders may not have shown in any open hunter or equitation division (see Novice Hunter). A blue ribbon in the Short Stirrup Equitation on the flat does not disqualify the rider for Short Stirrup Equitation over fences. Short Stirrup ribbon winners are still eligible for Maiden and Novice classes. Short Stirrup riders may not ride in Children's Pony Hunter or Equitation divisions. No tests.

Short Stirrup Small/Medium and Large Pony Equitation — Fences 18" for Small/Medium, 2' for Large.

MHJA 2011 'C' CIRCUIT CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

Beginner Junior Hunter: Open to junior riders who have not won three blue ribbons in a recognized Hunter class over fences at MHJA, MHSA, or USEF shows prior to October 1st of the preceding year, but do retain their beginner status for the show year. Riders having won in the Beginner division will not lose their Novice or Primary status. This division is not open to any riders who have shown in any Open Hunter or Equitation division at any MHJA, MHSA, or USEF shows. Riders may not cross enter into classes that require jumping 2'6" or higher. Fence Height 2', no oxers.

Beginner Adult Hunter: Open to adult riders (all other specs same as for juniors)

Very Green Hunter: Open to horses of any age in their FIRST year of showing at ANY recognized show. Horses may compete in under saddle and equitation on the flat without affecting their Green status. Fences 2' to 2' 3".

Baby Green Hunter: Open to horses in their FIRST year of showing at ANY recognized show. Open to all riders. Fences 2' 6".

Low Hunter: Open to all horses and riders. Fences 2' 6".

Primary Hunter: Open to riders who have not won 6 blue ribbons in any Hunter classes. May not have shown at 2' 9" or higher. Divisions for JUNIOR and ADULT. Fences 2' 3".

Intermediate Hunter: Open to riders who have not won 9 blue ribbons in any Hunter classes. May not have shown at 3' 0" or higher. Divisions for JUNIOR and ADULT. Fences 2' 6".

MHJA Intermediate MEDAL: Open to riders who are current members of the MHJA and who qualify for Intermediate Equitation. Fences 2' 6". Divisions for JUNIOR and ADULT.

Beginner Equitation: Open to riders who have not won three blue ribbons in any Equitation classes. Divisions for JUNIOR and ADULT. Fences 2'.

Primary Equitation: Open to riders who have not won 6 blue ribbons in any Equitation classes. May not have shown at 2' 9" or higher. Fences 2' 3".

Intermediate Equitation: Open to riders who have not won 9 blue ribbons in any equitation classes. May not have shown at 3' 0" or higher. Divisions for JUNIOR and ADULT. Fences 2' 6".

Warm Up: Open to all horses and riders. Fences 2', 2' 3" or 2' 6".

Training Jumper, Low Jumper, Low Mini-Jumper: Open to any rider mounted on horse or pony. Fences 2' 6". No in-and-out adjustments for ponies.

GENERAL NOTES FOR THE SHOW

Schooling Day: All courses will be set on a 12' stride measurement.

Pony Measurement: There is a \$10 measurement fee for ALL ponies. No one is exempt from this measurement fee. The measurement fee and the measurement form are to be mailed to the MHJA Office where a measurement card will be issued and mailed to the owner.

Note: No exhibitor may participate in any recognized 'C' Circuit Division if they have shown in any classes that require the rider to jump higher than 3'. Competing in any classes 2' 9" or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible.
